Policy statement

All of our full time and qualified staff have a valid paediatric first aid training. All of our staff including temporary staff and volunteers are aware who is first aid trained and where first aid box is located.

Procedures

The First Aid Kit

Our first aid kit contains the following items:

- Triangular bandages x 1.
- Sterile eye pads x 2.
- Safety pins
- Children's forehead 'strip' thermometer
- Disposable plastic (PVC or vinyl) gloves
- Scissors
- Eye bath
- Micropore tape
- 2 packs of low adherent dressings
- 2 small wound dressings
- 2 large wound dressings
- 2 emergency blankets
- 1 pack of antibacterial cleansing wipes
- Emergency burn care dressing
- 2 medium bandages
- 2 small bandages

The first aid box is easily accessible to adults and is kept out of the reach of children. The content of first aid box is checked half termly and used products resupplied. No un-prescribed medication is given to children or parents. At the time of admission to the setting, parents' written permission for emergency medical advice or treatment is sought. Parents sign and date their written approval. Parents sign a consent form on their registration form allowing staff to take their child to the nearest Accident and Emergency unit to be examined, treated or admitted as necessary on the understanding that parents have been informed and are on their way to the hospital.
